

After School Snack Program

What is the after school snack program?

The after school snack program is a federally assisted snack program operating in public schools and nonprofit private schools and residential child care institutions.

How does the after school snack program work?

Public or nonprofit private schools of high school grade or under may participate in the after school snack program. School districts and independent schools that choose to take part in the snack program must serve snacks that meet Federal requirements and they must offer free or reduced price snacks to eligible children.

What sites are eligible to participate in the after school snack program?

In order for a school site to participate, a school district must run the National School Lunch Program and sponsor or operate an afterschool care program. This afterschool care program must provide children with regularly scheduled educational or enrichment activities in a supervised environment. If at least 50% of your school site enrollment are eligible for free and reduced price meals, snacks will be at no cost.

How do I receive snacks for my after school program?

- Leaders of the after school program are required to view this presentation before snacks will be provided.
- Two weeks advance notice is required for starting any after school snack program.
- After completing this presentation, click on the link on the last page and complete the form. Once you submit the form, you will receive a confirmation email.
- Print the attachment in the email and present it to the cafeteria manager two weeks prior to the start of your after school program.

Rules of the after school snack program.

- A Justice For All Poster must be displayed in the cafeteria.
- Snacks are to be served in the cafeteria only, but may be consumed elsewhere.
- Students must be served the complete snack (snacks are pre-packaged and consist of a juice box and a whole grain snack).
- One snack per student, but sharing is allowed.
- Adults are not eligible to receive a snack.

Rules of the after school snack program (continued).

- Snacks must be eaten on site.
- A sign in sheet will be located with the snacks in the cafeteria. You will sign in with your name, afterschool program name, and the number of snacks you have served.
- A site review will be conducted twice per year by Nutrition Services.
